10 Warning Signs Your Family Member Needs Help

The holiday season may be one of the few times families get together and realize their elderly loved ones are deteriorating and

need some help. Holiday visits can often be a wakeup call that steps need to be taken to turn the situation around.

The Council on Aging offers theses 10 warning signs that your family member needs help:

- Poor eating habits may resulting in weight loss; no appetite or missed meals
- Neglected Hygiene: wearing dirty clothes, body odor, neglected nails and teeth
- Neglected home that is not as clean or sanitary as you remember growing up
- Forgetfulness or failure to take medications
- Changed relationship patterns that neighbors have noticed
- Burns or injuries resulting from weakness
- Decreased participation in activities such as church or social groups
- Scorched pots and pans, or forgetting to turn off the stove
- Unopened mail, newspaper piles or missed appointments
- Mishandled finances such as losing money, forgetting to pay bills or paying bills twice.

If you notice any of these signs, it's time to decide on the best form of care for your relative. When meeting as a family it's best to encourage participation from everyone. Write things down and keep communication open. Holidays are supposed to be joyous, so consider the wakeup call a blessing. Now that you are aware they need help, you will be able to contribute to a better quality of life and contribute to your relative's safety.
